

## Intrastat Delivery Terms Legislation Update

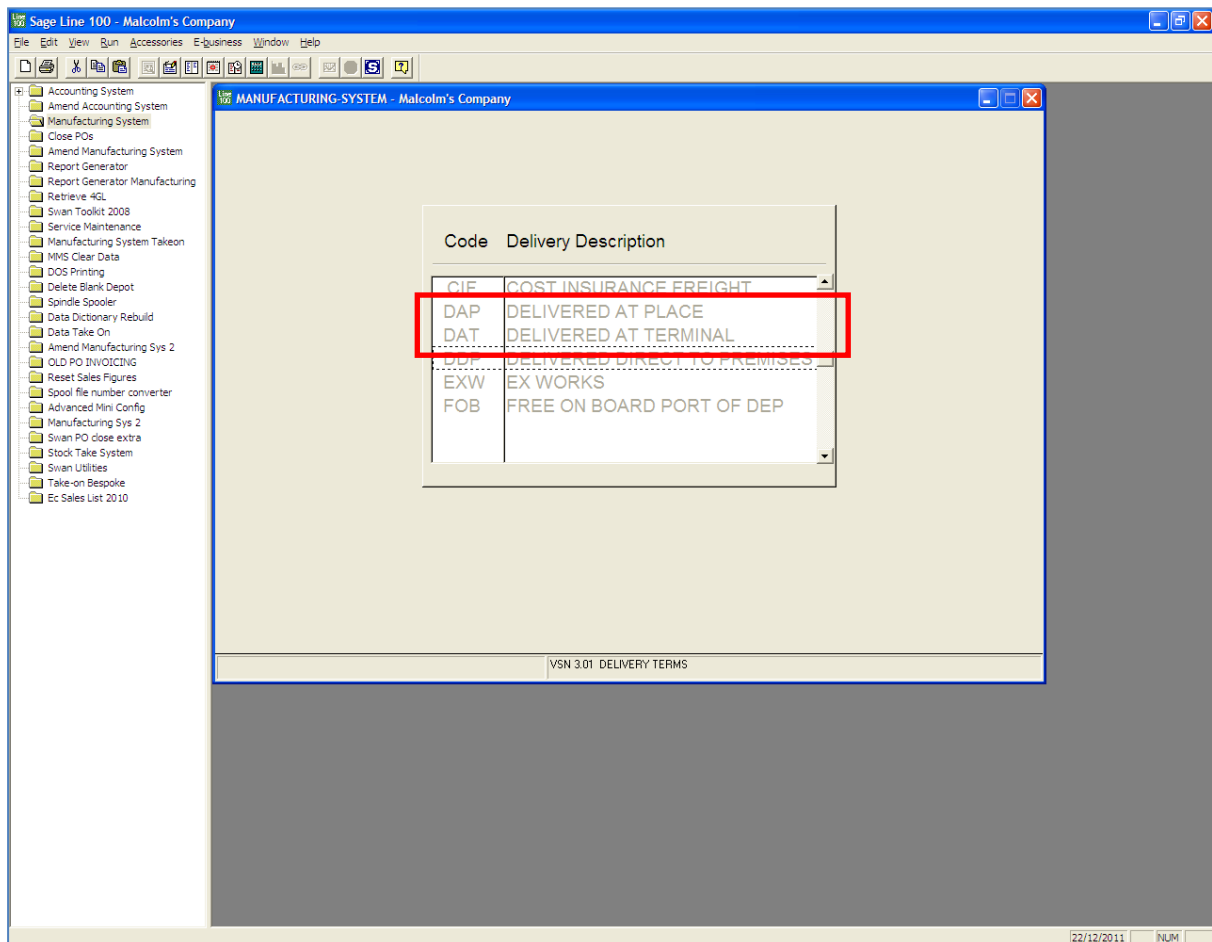
The International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) have made changes to their Incoterms (international commercial terms). For Intrastat purposes Incoterms are referred to as Delivery Terms. These changes took place in February 2011 and saw the introduction of two new terms:

- DAT (Delivered at Terminal) replaces the term DEQ
- DAP (Delivered at Place) replaces the terms DAF, DES and DDU.

HMRC will continue to accept the older terms until 31<sup>st</sup> December 2011, but from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012 onwards businesses **must** use the new terms on all Intrastat Declarations.
